

# MDFourier macOS GUI usage notes

- MDFourier checks for updates every time you launch it, if you have an internet connection available. If an update is found, it is automatically installed.
- You can drag & drop files from anywhere onto the Reference, Comparison and Extra Commands fields, you don't have to use the file browser.
- You can use custom profiles! Just choose "Custom" in the Profile popup and then specify -P "/path/to/customProfile.mfn" in the Extra Commands. Remember to enclose the path with double quotes so you can use also file paths and file names with spaces. Just like Reference and Comparison, you can drag & drop the profile file in the Extra Commands field so you don't have to manually write the entire path.
- All fields have tooltips! Don't know what a certain option does? Just hover over it with your cursor for a couple seconds and a tooltip will come up explaining what that option does.
- The output files are saved in your Documents folder at ~/Documents/MDFourier
- You can find this Readme file at ~/Documents/MDFourier/Readme.pdf
- By default, the MDFourier main GUI window floats above all the other windows. You can change this behavior by unchecking "Stay on top" and restarting the app. You can do this quickly by just clicking the Execute button with all fields empty: it will throw a harmless error and relaunch the GUI.
- By default, MDFourier will automatically open the resulting plots in Preview after a successful run. You can change this behavior by unchecking "Open output".
